- 2) **President Edmondson** Report on annual winter meeting (2/14/08).
 - *McLane is deficient because it was designed for 4 varsity sports teams. Sports teams have grown tremendously since then.
 - *Major study done in 2003: it would require \$48 million to serve our needs.
 - *Looking at a student recreation and wellness center. It would be about 50,000 ft². Primarily for general student use. A plan for this will be presented at the board meeting in May.
 - *New decisions: 95% sure that it will be at the North end of McLane which is big enough/flat enough for location. It will be a steel structure and they will have to replace parking spaces.
 - *It will have a full track, multi-purpose courts(4), a fitness area and aerobics area.
 - *Kathy Woughter will have a committee to help decide layout and content.
 - *This should be a \$8 million contract and they want to break ground next October
 - *We need this facility soon since Davis isn't appropriate.
 - *Davis will be taken down in May of 2009. Not sure when the new facility will be completed. Will try to complete new facility before Davis is demolished.
 - *Doesn't anticipate student fees to go up.
 - *Student clubs and intramurals will have priority on the space. Varsity sports are not the focus.
 - *Miller expansion over the summer will not close Ade parking lot.
 - *If parking lot is moved to up by pine hill then safety lighting, sidewalks, etc will be taken care of.
