Senate Minutes from April 23rd, 2008

- 1) Call to order by President, Nate Kisselburgh 8:03 pm
- 2) Speaker John Dietrich
 - § John Dietrich came to talk about the future plans he has for dining services. His main focus right now is on improving environment issues. One of his ideas is to start buying products from local places. Products that would be bought locally would be beef and pork because right now they don't know where the meat is coming from. Also buying these products from local places would be good because they would be fresh and it would help out the local businesses.
 - S Dietrich is also working on other issues and ideas but he would love your input on how to improve the services. They have a Student Advisory Board where there are only about 3 students, he would like to have more students involved. If you would like to join the board, please email John Dietrich or come to their meeting time on Thursdays at 2:15pm outside Cyber Fresh. If you would like to join but can't make the meeting time, please email Dietrich and you can work out something with him.
 - § Another idea Dietrich had was having meal swipes at Cyber Fresh just like they do at Midnight Express. This would start at 8:30pm everyday, when the dining halls are closed. Some of the items on the menu would change to reduce the cost. An example of a meal would be a *chicken basket* with chicken tenders, fries and a fountain drink. Also there would be items such as the grab to go items, this could be a prepared sandwich, chips, fruits and fountain drink or you could have a salad instead of the sandwich.
 - Questions students asked: Why is it when you pay with your dining dollars, there are no taxes but there are taxes when you pay with regular money? This is because dining dollars are more like points than money and you won't get them back. Money on the other hand you will get back as change, so you must pay the state taxes like you do when you go shopping. How many guest swipes do you have? The bigger the meal plan you have the more guest swipes you have. Also, remember you can use your guest swipes on your self, if you are running low on meals.
 - § Dietrich stated that it is important that you bring your ID Card to swipe in to the dinning halls, if you lose your ID Card please make sure you report it right away, so that other people won't use your meal swipes.
 - Are more vending machines going to have ID Card systems? There are 15 machines that already have them. John Dietrich said that he thinks that Kathy Woughter will bring in 5 new machines each year with the ID systems. Make sure that if you have any questions or want a refund from the vending machines because it doesn't work or it didn't give you items, please come down to Cyber Fresh.
 - Why don't the televisions in Ade Hall work? They do not work because of a cable problem, but they are working on it. Dietrich also mentioned that it's important that your fill out a comment card, if you have any questions or comments.
 - § Next week, on Wednesday April 30, 2008 there is going to be a Barbeque outside Ade Dining Hall; Dietrich stated you should go before Senate begins.
